FINANCIAL AID

Recipients of this aid enjoy up to 100% discount on tuition, and the waiver of capital development and matriculation fees. Financial Aid is granted only to Filipino citizens and to one child per family.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

NOTE: All applicants must successfully pass the Admissions screening before applying for any scholarship or financial aid grant.

- 1. Complete the Scholarship and Financial Aid application forms and requirements through this link. https://form.jotform.com/admissions505/scholarship-and-financial-aid-appli
- 2. Prepare a letter of intent to be uploaded to the application link. This should be written by the student applicant stating the type of scholarship applied for and the rationale behind the scholarship application OR the rationale behind the request for Financial Aid.
- 3. Upload a pdf or image format (jpeg, jpg, or png) of the applicant's portfolio showing his/her summary of achievements including sample works, copies of certifications, awards, honors, citations received, etc. These should be properly labeled (i.e. nature of event/activity, date or year, etc.).
- 4. Upload copies of the Income Tax Return of both parents or legal guardian for the past two (2) years showing all sources of income.
- 5. Upload a copy of the Certificate of Employment of both parents or legal guardian stating the designation or position in the company, and annual salary.
- 6. Download the Scholarship Recommendation Form through the scholarship application link and have an authority related to the type of scholarship applied for (i.e. academic adviser, athletic coach, creative mentor, community service coordinator, etc.) accomplish it and send it to this email address: admissions@beaconacademy.ph
- 7. For Financial Aid applicants, please download and complete the Financial Aid Data form from the scholarship application link and upload it together with proofs of financial obligations (if any), showing monthly payments, payments on loans, mortgages, and other debts, including other educational payments for other children, etc.
